

The dress code policy of Immaculate Conception School reflects that the students' dress shall be neat, conducive to learning, and consistent with Christian values.

GENERAL DRESS CODE RULES FOR ALL:

- Students are to be neatly dressed/well groomed.
- All clothing is to be modest, of proper fit, neat, clean, and appropriate to weather conditions. Undergarments are not to be visible (Including: above waistline & through shirt.)
- Pants with frayed cuffs, rips, or split seams are not acceptable.
- Hats may not be worn in the building, unless a school-sponsored activity allows hats to be worn that day.
- Accessories (bandanas, adorned belts, etc.) are not permitted.
- Ink marks on arms and legs are inappropriate. Students writing on themselves or others is unacceptable.
- Visible tattoos and jewelry in body piercings other than girls' earrings are not permitted.
- Girls are allowed to wear nail polish and earrings; boys are not. (Large hoop & long-dangling earrings are not allowed).
- Logos advertising alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or inappropriate behavior are not allowed. Anything written that appears to be suggestive is also not allowed.
- Boy's hair length in back may not overhang the collar. Hair must be clean, neat, combed and not hang in front of eyes.
- Girl's hair must be neat, clean, combed, and not hang in front of eyes.
- The appropriateness of hairstyle and coloring will be determined by the administration. Mohawks will not be permitted. Hair color is to be a natural hair color.

NO DRESS CODE POLICY CAN POSSIBLY COVER ALL EVENTUALITIES OR POSSIBILITIES. IF AN ITEM IS NOT MENTIONED HEREIN AS BEING ALLOWED, IT IS NOT TO BE WORN.

Questionable adherence to the dress code will be brought to the attention of the assistant principal for final determination of non-adherence. Non-adherence shall be addressed as follows:

Grades K-4

Dress code violation notices with explanation of possible consequences will be sent home at time of infraction.

Grades 5-8

Dress code violation notices and explanation of possible consequences will be noted in student planner

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION SCHOOL POLICY FOR CASUAL DRESS DAYS

“Casual Dress” days will occasionally be scheduled. Although these days are designed for casual dress, there are still expectations for dress that is neat, conducive for learning and in line with Christian values. The I. C. Student Council will occasionally schedule thematic dress down days. Please see the chart below for guidelines for these days.

CASUAL DRESS CODE (Revised 4/26/18)	
Pants	Blue jeans, sweat pants, wind pants, and Knit (loose fitting for gr. K-3 only) permitted Not permitted: Yoga, Knit (Gr 4-8), spandex, or stretch; pants with writing across the bottom
Shorts/Capris	Required: No shorter than 3“ above top of knee cap (shorts) Not permitted: Yoga, Knit (Gr 4-8), spandex, or stretch; pants with writing across the bottom. Cannot be worn November through February
Girls--Jumpers, Skirts, Dresses, and Skorts	Required: Shorts must be worn under skirts, dresses, and jumpers. No shorter than 3“above top of knee cap. Tights or leggings under skirts skorts, or jumpers from November through February
Leggings/Tights	May only be worn under a skirt or dress that is no shorter than 3” above top of knee cap. Leggings worn November through February must be ankle length.
Shirts	Thin straps, tank, or open shoulder tops are permitted only with proper covering under or over the straps to eliminate bare shoulders. Not permitted: Halter tops or strapless tops
Shoes	Fully enclosed Not permitted: Sandals, flip flops or Crocs Tennis Shoes Required for Preschool through 2 nd grade. Tennis Shoes Mandatory for PE days (no canvas including Converse)
Socks (Required)	Required: Must be visible from top of shoe

IC SPIRIT SHIRT DAYS
IC Spirit Shirt Days are held every Tuesday (except the second Tuesday of the month which is a dress down day). Students may wear any IC themed shirt with uniform bottoms. The shirt may be a purchased IC Spirit Shirt, Athletic IC shirt, IC Club shirt, etc. Helias shirts are not permitted on IC Spirit Days.

IT IS IMPORTANT TO REMEMBER THAT STUDENTS MAY BE ATTENDING SERVICES IN CHURCH ON DRESS DOWN DAYS. EVEN THOUGH THE ATTIRE FOR THESE DAYS IS CASUAL, IT IS STILL TO BE RESPECTFUL FOR CHURCH.

NOTE: IF AN ARTICLE OF CLOTHING IS DEEMED TOO IMMODEST OR IMMORAL BY THE ADMINISTRATION, STUDENTS WILL NOT BE GIVEN A WARNING. THEY MUST HAVE PROPER ATTIRE BEFORE THEY WILL BE READMITTED TO CLASS.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE (Revised 5/3/21)

Pants	Solid navy or khaki (tan), cargo, Knit (loose fitting for gr. K-3 only) acceptable Not permitted: Knit (Gr 4-8), spandex or stretch pants.
Shorts/Capris	Solid navy or khaki, Knit (loose fitting for gr. K-3 only) Not permitted: Knit (Gr 4-8), spandex or stretch; Cannot be worn November through February Required: No shorter than 3" above top of knee cap (shorts)
Girls--Jumpers, Skirts, and Skorts	Solid navy or khaki Required: Shorts must be worn under skirts, dresses, and jumpers. No shorter than 3" above top of knee cap. Tights/ leggings under skirts, skorts, or jumpers from November through February
Collared Knit Dress	Navy only Required: Tights or leggings under dresses from November through February . No shorter than 3" above top of kneecap.
Leggings /Tights	Permitted under uniform skirts, jumpers, skorts, and dresses in solid white, navy, black, or khaki (Leggings worn Nov. through Feb. must be ankle length.)
Shirts	Solid white, navy, IC and Helias logo shirts and color blocked shirts in navy/white Not permitted: Patterns; logo larger than 1 1/2" in diameter; No club team logo Required: Collar
Sweaters	Solid white, navy, khaki, or Helias navy V neck Required: Must be worn over approved collared shirt
Sweatshirts	Solid white or navy crew neck or hoodie IC and Helias logo in white or navy (1/2 zippered micro fleece) IC logo sherpa only Required: Must be worn over approved collared shirt
Vests	Solid white, navy, or khaki Required: Must be worn over approved collared shirt
Tee shirt	Solid white, navy, khaki, or black Not permitted: Writing on garment Required: Must be worn as undershirt ONLY
Scarves and Ties	Solid black, white, navy, cream, grey, or khaki
Belts	Solid white, black, navy blue, brown or combination of these colors Required: Grades 4-8
Shoes	Fully enclosed Not permitted: Sandals, flip flops or Crocs Tennis Shoes Required for Preschool through 2 nd grade Tennis Shoes Mandatory for PE days (no canvas including Converse)
Socks (Required)	Solid white or black (Small trademark on socks are permitted) Not Permitted: Stripes/designs Required: Must be visible from top of shoe
