Immaculate Conception School was opened in 1914. The original two-story combination church and school of 90 students initially operated by five Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word has grown to a three building facility housing around 325 students, pre-kindergarten through eighth grade.

Immaculate Conception is characterized by an interdependent support system in which parents, teachers, administration, and the parish family work together to share their faith, time, talent, and financial resources for the educational growth and Christian development of its students. This interdependence is deeply rooted in parish tradition and generations of support.

Immaculate Conception School recognizes the parents of the parish as primary educators of their children and assists them in their role. Our goal is to create a strong foundation of faith, to ask challenging societal questions, and to present student-centered authentic experiences allowing each student to grow into a productive citizen in the church and the world. Opportunities will be provided for students to learn, play, and pray daily.

ADMISSION AGE

A child must be three years of age before August 1 of that school year for admission into the preschool program. The child must be fully toilet-trained and be able to dress him/herself.

DRESS CODE

Girls and boys may wear casual dress clothes such as blue jeans, sweatpants, wind-pants, t-shirts and sweatshirts. Skirts and jumpers must be no more than three inches from the top of the kneecap. Shorts, culottes, and skorts can be at or below fingertip length. Children must wear tennis shoes daily.
