Approval of Minutes

- The August minutes were approved without change and signed.

Principal's Report

- Heather had consultation with Jefferson City Public Schools
 - Title 2A funding has increased slightly, Title 4 monies will be incorporated into Title 2A funding as Title 2A monies are more easily spent. This is typically spent on professional development monies.
- Heather indicated Dept of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE) plans to remove Title 1 bypass monies in Missouri, most likely not occurring until 2027. This funding is for services provided by Abby Struempf; therefore, the hope is the discontinuation of this funding will not affect the services Ms. Struempf provides to the school.
- No school next Monday, September 30. First diocesan professional development day offered at Helias, focusing on class management and rising curriculum.
- Next Tuesday, October 1, grades 3-8 will attend a talk from Megan Meyer on anti-bullying at St Joseph Cathedral.
- Achievement testing is scheduled for October 7-11.
- Heather provided a copy of the budget for August for review. She indicated there are new leaks in the gym roof. A company will be visiting next week to assess the damage and repair costs.

The students will be informed of this during school tomorrow and a letter will be sent home to parents. Dependent on the success for grades 5-8, this will be extended to grades 1-4 later in the school year.
- Heather stated she will be emailing a list of new school families (10 total this year so far) to council members to contact a family or two asking how the student(s) are settling in this year and answer any questions they may have.
